1. **ANNOUNCEMENT:**

The Mt Gambier Motorcycle & Light Car Club Inc, hereafter called the PROMOTER will conduct interclub road racing at McNamara Park Mt Gambier, on Saturday 1st & Sunday 2nd October 2011

2. **JURISDICTION:**

- 2.1 The above mentioned meeting has been authorised by Motorcycling SA Inc which has issued the Motorcycling Australia Permit Number **C11124** and is open to holders of current financial members of the Mt Gambier Motor Cycle & Light Car Club Inc. Atujara MCC, Café Racer, Phoenix (including those taking out a 5 day membership as laid out in the Mt Gambier Motor Cycle and Light Car Club Constitution) All riders must be either holders of a current M.A. National or Club Road Race licence or must take out a one event licence for the meeting. Riders in the latter category must have previous road race experience or have passed a licence testing application prior to the meeting (this can be organised by contacting the MGMC & LC Clubs Coach on 08 87672839 or by contacting a Club near you) Application for a one event licence must be made simultaneously with submission of entry form, issue of the licence is conditional upon the rider competing in only those events and on those machines as specified on the entry form. The issue of the one event licences will be at the discretion of the Secretary of the Meeting, with right of appeal to the Steward as per GCR's. 14 year old competitors with Junior Licences endorsed for Road Racing in the 125ccGP Class are also eligible to enter. The race meeting will also be open to Junior riders 9 to under 13 70cc manual and 13-15 years of age with solo machines 80cc 2 stroke and 160cc 4 stroke & have completed the compulsory 5 hours coaching.
- 2.2 The meeting will be held in accordance with the current General Competition Rules (GCR's), these Supplementary Regulations, and any final instructions approved by Motorcycling SA Inc.

BY ENTERING THIS MEETING ALL PARTIES AGREE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES, REGULATIONS, BY-LAWS AND INSTRUCTIONS.

3. **ENTRIES:**

- 3.1 Entries open forthwith and close last mail Friday 23rd September 2011. Send entries to the Race Secretary at the above address or scan and email to racesec@macpark.org or fax to 08 87673150
- 3.2 In the case of postponement or abandonment of the meeting, all or any part of the entry fee may be retained by the Mt Gambier Motor Cycle & Light Car Club Inc if such retention is approved by Motorcycling SA Inc.
- 3.3 Only entries received on the official entry form that is accompanied by the correct fee will be accepted.
- 3.4 **NOTE: - LATE ENTRIES AND ENTRIES WITHOUT PAYMENT WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED AND THE RETURN OF ENTRY FEES FOR ANY RIDER WITHDRAWING FROM THE MEETING IS AT THE DISCRETION OF THE MT GAMBIER MOTORCYCLE & LIGHT CAR CLUB INC**

4. **INSURANCE:**

- 4.1 National Personal Accident Scheme provides basic cover for death and permanent disability.
- 4.2 Ambulance Insurance is compulsory for licensees.

4.3 **IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED THAT COMPETITORS GIVE CONSIDERATION TO TAKING OUT WEEKLY BENEFITS INSURANCE**

5. **MEDICAL SERVICES:**

A SA Ambulance or Paramedics will be in attendance at all times during Saturday 1st & Sunday 2nd October 2011

6 **ENTRY FEE:**

6.1. Senior Entry Fee (inc Mandatory MSA rider Levy) -\$200

Sidecar Entry Fee (inc 2 x Mandatory MSA rider levy) – \$210.

Junior Entry Fee (inc Mandatory MSA rider Levy)- \$140

One Event Licence - \$45

5 day membership – Included in Entry Fee

Note: All entry fees include \$20 cost of transponder + all additional bikes will incur an extra \$20 transponder fee per bike.

6.2. Payment by Direct Deposit to Mt Gambier Motor Cycle & Light Car Club Inc, Commonwealth Bank, BSB 065 504, Account 00420116 (Please include a copy of stamped deposit or receipt with your entry) or by personal cheque, bank cheque, money order to the above address or in cash in person at one of our track days on the last Saturday of every month or during a committee meeting on the second Tuesday of every month. **ANY FEES FOR DISHONOURED CHEQUES WILL BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE ENTRANT.**

6.3. Cheques and Money Orders are to be made payable to the Mt Gambier Motorcycle & Light Car Club Inc (MGMC & LCC inc)

6.4. Please Note: Acceptance forms & passes will not be sent out. Event and Rider listings will be posted on our website at www.macpark.org after entries close. If you cannot get access to the internet, phone 08 87672839 for confirmation. Passes can be collected from Scrutineering Shed when you sign in.

7 **ENTRY PASSES:**

Each Solo Rider entered shall receive 2 passes for each day.

Each Sidecar Rider entered shall receive 3 passes for each day.

Participants quoting a current Entrants Licence shall receive 1 extra pass for each day.

Additional passes may be ordered on the entry form.

No passes required for Friday practice.

8 **CLASSES OF COMPETITION**

JUNIORS

Nippers- Up to 70cc machines as per 2011 MA GCR's. Competitors must be aged from 9yrs to 13yrs.

Junior 2- Up to 85cc 2 stroke machines as per 2011 MA GCR's. Competitors must be aged from 13yrs to 16yrs

Junior 4 – Up to 160cc 4 stroke machines as per 2011 MA GCR's. Competitors must be aged from 13yrs to 16yrs.

125 GP - 125 GP machines as per 2011 MA GCR's, may be run with Formula Mac Park.

250 Mono - 250 Four Stroke, Single Cylinder machines as per 2011 MA GCR's, may be run with Formula Mac Park

SENIORS

Over 600cc- 4 stroke over 600cc 4-cyl, over 675cc 3 cyl & over 750cc 2 cyl machines complying with GCRs. Tyre choice open.

600cc- 4 stroke 600cc- 4 cyl, 675cc 3-cyl & 750cc 2 cyl machines complying with GCRs. Tyre choice open.

20th Century- Machines designated plated 1999 model or earlier incorporating motorcycling eligible for Period 6 as per GCRs.

Historic Group 1- Consisting of Period 3, Combined 125cc & Superlights

Historic Group 2- Consisting of Period 4 & 5

Formula Mac Park- 2 Stroke & 4 stroke multi-cylinder machines up to 400cc are eligible, twin cylinder machines to 650cc (to 750cc 2 valve only) and single cylinder machines up to 800cc. 125ccGP Junior and Seniors are also included in this class. Riders of 250ccGP and 250cc Production machines are encouraged to participate. Historic bikes without log books.

COMBINED SIDECARS

Sidecar Scratch race: Open to any motorcycle with sidecar of any period

FEATURE RACES: The Club will conduct the following feature races:

The Master of Mac Park- Open to invited A, B and selected C grade riders on machines of 600cc and above at the discretion of the Club. Grid positions will be from times set in qualifying on Saturday morning. Superpole to take place on Saturday afternoon.

Consolation Master of Mac Park - Open to C & D grade riders and those not selected for the Master of Mac at the discretion of the Club.

The Laurie Fox Classic Master of Mac Park - open to Period 3 machines.

The Post Classic/Forgotten Era Master of Mac Park - open to Period 4 and 5 machines.

The Sidecar Master of Mac Park – open to sidecars.

Junior Master of Mac Park -open to Junior Riders

AWARDS AND PRIZEMONEY:

(See table at end of Sup Regs)

Awards- First overall point scorers will receive Free Entry Voucher valid for 12 months unless indicated otherwise and according to the following numbers of competitors: - Races of where there is one entrant only in a class, no award will be awarded.

Trophies- Second and Third overall point scorers receive trophies unless indicated otherwise and according to the following numbers of competitors:-Races of where there is one competitor only in a class, no award/trophy will be awarded, 2 to 3 competitors first only; Races of 4-6 competitors- first and second, Races of 7 or more competitors-first, second and third. Number of award/trophies per class will be based on numbers at official close of entries. No late entries after official program is printed.

Period of Holding Awards- awards to be picked up at the Presentation Ceremony following the race meeting. If you are unable to attend the Ceremony please nominate someone to collect for you. Awards/Trophies will not be held.

9 ENTRIES TO CONSTITUTE A CLASS:

9.1 Should there be insufficient entries in any class of the competition, the decision to run or cancel the class, or to combine events and re-distribute any awards and / or prizemoney, will be at the discretion of the club, subject to Motorcycling SA Inc. approval.

10 RACE FORMAT:

All heats, races and laps for all Classes as laid out in "Awards" table at the end of Sup Regs

11 MACHINES AND RIDERS:

- 11.1 All machines entered must comply with the current GCRs for Road Race competition. Attention is drawn to the following points.
- 11.2 All modern machines front brake caliper bolts to be lockwired in the tightened position as per GCR's
- 11.3 All modern machines must have engine end case protectors fitted as per GCR's
- 11.4 Multiple entry of the one machine in the same class of competition is not permitted.
- 11.5 Change of machine by permission of Clerk of Course, original allocated number to be fitted.
- 11.6 Spare machines MUST be entered and scrutineered at official scrutineering.
- 11.7 Wherever possible, competitors will be allocated their registered riding number or their preferred riding number. All others will be allocated numbers at the Club's discretion.
- 11.8 All number plates on all machines MUST comply with the GCR's

12 GRID POSITIONS:

- 12.1 For all classes starting positions will be determined by 2 timed Qualifying Sessions on Saturday morning
- 12.2 Superpole for Master of Mac Park to be held on Saturday afternoon.

13 RIDERS' BRIEFING:

13.1 A riders' briefing will be held prior to the commencement of racing, which ALL competitors MUST attend. All riders MUST sign in at Riders Brief.

14 DRUG AND OR ALCOHOL TESTING:

- 14.1 All competitors and officials are advised that as part of the MA and MSA drug education program, drug testing may take place at any competition in accordance with Australian Sports Commission policy as implemented by the Australian Sports Drug Agency and the Motorcycling SA Drug and Alcohol Policy.
- 14.2 If any doubts exist over banned substances it is recommended that competitors contact the Drugs in Sport Hotline, tel 1800 020 506. When drug testing takes place, the payment of prizemoney may be delayed at the discretion of Motorcycling SA Inc. until the results of the tests are known.

15 CODE OF CONDUCT:

All competitors, officials and parents are reminded of the Motorcycling Australia by-law - CODE OF CONDUCT (as stipulated in the GCRs), which is a guide to appropriate behaviour at all motorcycle race meetings. This CODE OF CONDUCT applies to this Meeting and will be enforced.

16 TIMETABLE:

Saturday- Scrutineering from 7.30am to 9.30am. Riders Briefing at 8.30am. Practice and Qualifying from 9am with racing to follow
Sunday- Riders Brief at 8.30am if requested by the Clerk of Course. Limited Practice from 9am with racing to follow.

For the purposes of drug and alcohol testing, the commencement of the meeting will be deemed to be 7.30am with the completion of the meeting for the participant being half hour after their last event.

17 CIRCUIT DESCRIPTION:

17.1 Races will be conducted on a sealed course of 2.4km in a clockwise direction.

18 STARTS:

18.1 All Starts will be clutch start. Starting will be by lights; RED -for prepare to start, RED light off- for start. An amber light will flash if a start is aborted.

19 RACING:

19.1 All heats, races and laps for all classes as laid out in "Awards" table at end of Sup Regs.

20. NOISE:

As per GCR's

21. GST:

The Goods and Services Tax affects the payment of prizemoney. If you do not provide an ABN or declare the sport is a hobby, the Promoter must withhold 48.5% of prizemoney over \$50.00 which is otherwise payable to you. Please tick one of the boxes on the entry form and if appropriate provide your ABN to ensure the full amount of prize money is paid to you.

22. SPECIAL NOTES AND WARNINGS:

22.1 Pit Enclosure- The pit enclosure is a dead engine area, except the bitumised entry and exit roads.

22.2 Scrutineering- All riders must wear racing apparel. All machines with fairings must have the belly pan removed and all old scrutineering stickers must be removed.

22.3 Garages- A limited number of powered garages available in the pit area at \$70 per bay for the weekend. One bay per entry. (Comfortably fits 2 bikes) New Sheds 37-42 are available at \$100 per bay for the weekend. Only one bay per entry. (Comfortably fits 3 bikes) Booking will only be accepted on receipt of Entry Form when accompanied by full payment.

22.4 All Historic machines must have log books presented at machine examining or no start as per GCR's

22.5 Timing: Timing will be electronic and EACH machine will be allocated a transponder; the hire charges are included in the entry fee. Riders will be responsible for the safe return of their transponder and a fee will be charged for loss or damage. Before transponders are handed over, competitors will need to provide security to the hirer at the track. Those who hold a MA National licence will need to hand over their licences. Those who are competing under a One Event Licence will be required to provide a \$50 deposit for each transponder. The security will be handed back when the transponders are returned in good order to the hirer.

22.6 Camping- Bushland style camping is available for a fee of \$10 per person per day. Under 16's free. Camping can commence 4pm Wednesday 28th September till 10am Monday 3rd October 2011.

22.7 NO ALCOHOL PERMITTED IN THE PIT AREA AS PER GCR'S

22.8 NO ANIMALS PERMITTED WITHIN THE CIRCUIT BOUNDARY AS PER GCR'S

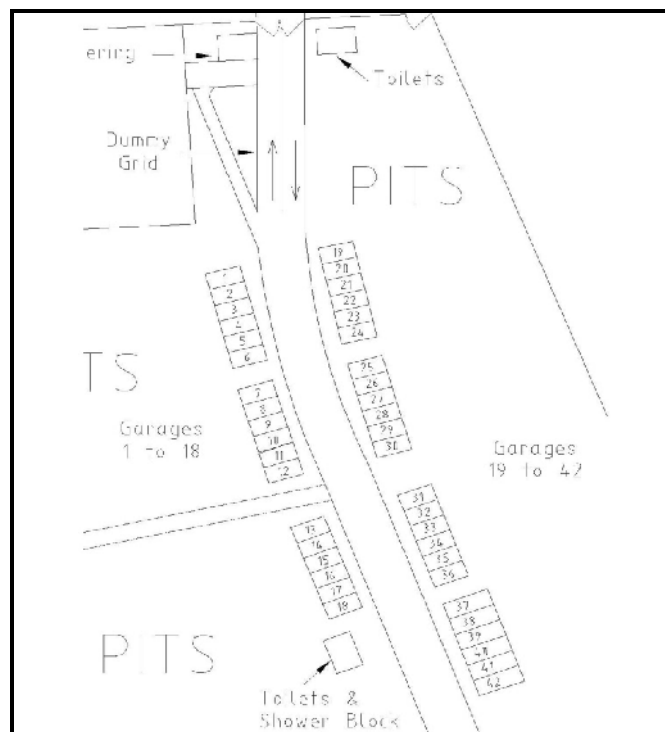
